Some of our students are lucky enough to be the beneficiaries.



Amanda Berndt has tutored at Summit for a total of five years, three of those while in the dental school, and has worked with Karina for four of the five years. "I originally came to Summit because it was a service learning site as an undergrad and I just fell in love with the program." She added that "I love the fact that it is one-on-one and I get to work with Karina every week. I have seen her really grow over the years." "I have gotten to know the parents really well and was really blessed to have Karina and her family at my wedding." It's no wonder that Karina aspires to be a dentist when she gets older.

Ryan Misculin tutored at Summit for two years before graduating from dental school last spring. He especially appreciated the fundamental Christian values fostered in the character talks at Summit which he says "are often times lacking in culture." He adds that "In this way, these children will be provided a foundation to help form lives that are successful, meaningful, and ultimately, service-orientated towards God and others."



Magdalena Hornik and her student have "relatable struggles" because she moved to Chicago from Poland when she was nine, and her student, Esmeralda, is also nine. Magdalena spoke no English when she arrived being the eldest of several siblings whose parents also did not speak English.



Madeline Carney's parents are also dentists and Madeline has accompanied them on about 20 missionary trips where they helped very poor people with dental care, so she is used to making a difference in people's lives. She loves working with her student Kimberly because she is "like a little sister" who reminds her of when she was a young girl.

Larry Lopina was a former CFO of Broan Industries who brought a wealth of expertise to Summit for almost 25 years by volunteering as our accountant.

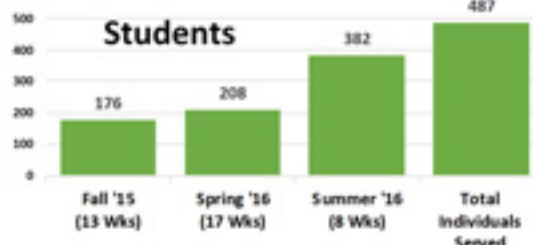
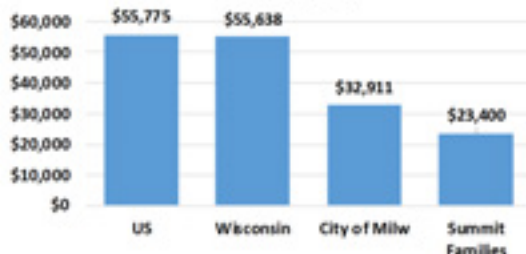

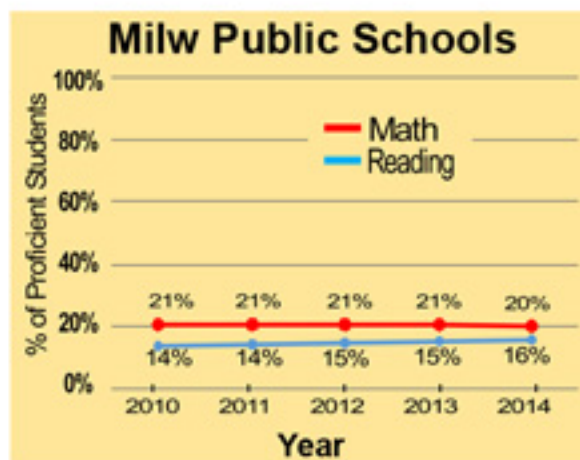
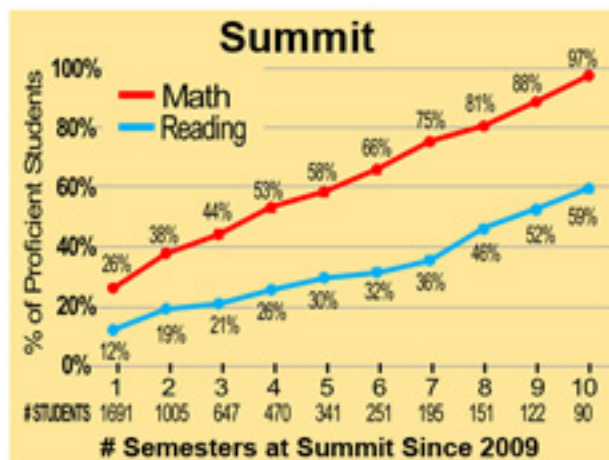
Character Measure - Parent Survey

 Source: Results of bi-lingual written survey from 71 parents done in December, 2015.



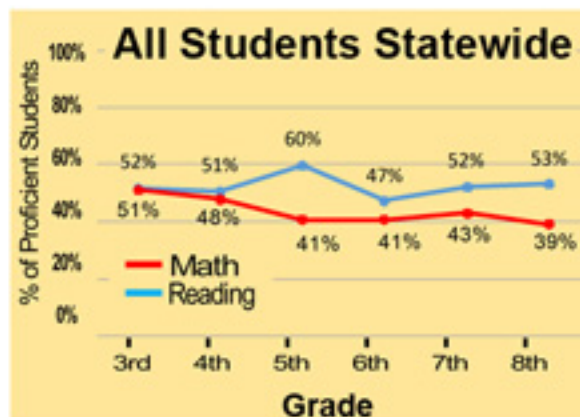
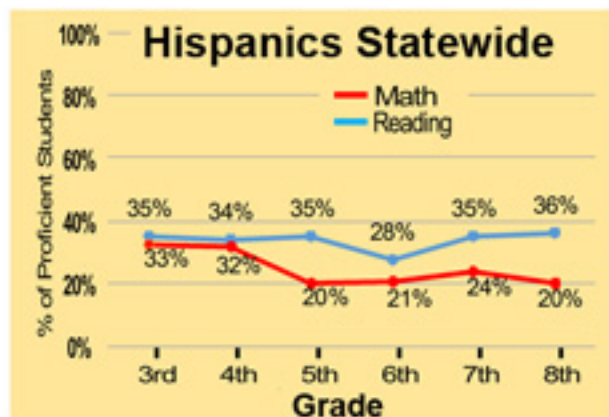
Academic Measure - Grade Level Testing
